What personal data do we process?

The www.3dty.fi online service does not collect personal data about its users and therefore we do not disclose personal data to third parties.

What is the legal basis for processing?

The University of Oulu fulfils the statutory task given in section 2 of the Universities Act on the basis of public interest when it researches, teaches and engages in societal interaction.

In accordance with Art. 6 (1) c) of the EU General Data Protection Regulation, processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject.

How is your data processed?

The website of the www.3dty.fi online service may contain services of third-party social plugins, such as YouTube and LinkedIn.

Plug-ins maintained by third parties in the online service are downloaded from the services' own servers. The social media functions of the pages used by the visitor are transferred to the tracking data of the third-party service. The online service does not send customer data through social plugins.

Services provided by a third party or applications mediated by a third party in the www.3dty.fi online service are subject to the third party's own terms of use and other terms.

Is your personal data transferred outside the EU/EEA and how are data transfers protected?

Some of the services provided by third parties may be located in countries outside the European Economic Area.

Video and audio content may be embedded on the site through third-party platforms. The www.3dty.fi online service is not responsible if you use third-party services through its website (e.g. Youtube, Spotify and Transistor).

Data retention period

The data will be stored for five years after the end of the project and will not be used for any other purpose.

How can you exercise your rights?

Right of appeal
